HOW YOUR FUNDRAISING, HELPS SUPPORT OUR CHARITY MAIN AIMS AND MISSION



£50 Purchases ten SD storage cards for Abigail's Place, bereavement suite in Medway.

£350 Funds six counselling sessions, for bereaved parents with a specialist baby loss counsellor.

£1,000 Funds a one day training course, for up to 35 midwives or health care professionals to attend.

£2,800 An Abi cooling cot, enables families to spend time together, after the death of a baby, to make memories.



1) START PLANNING...

Think about all the people you know! Ask your friends, family, colleagues, local businesses, you'll be surprised by how much help and sponsorship you'll receive. Many companies will happily donate prizes for fundraising events, use our 'letter to request donations' to make it official.

2) SET UP A FUNDRAISING PAGE ONLINE...

Setting up your fundraising page is really quick and simple. There are lots of different online 'giving' pages and most of them will transfer funds raised directly through to us, making it very easy to manage donations. You can even get a unique QR code for your page, to share on social media.

3) TELL EVERYONE WHAT YOU'RE DOING...

Make it easy for your family, friends & colleagues to donate. Use social media to tell them what you're doing and why you're doing it, share your story and spread the word.

4) MATCH FUNDING...

Whether you're raising money in the office or outside of work, ask your employer about match funding. Lots of our fundraisers have doubled their end target by asking employers to match it, so don't be afraid to ask.

5) SENDING YOUR DONATIONS TO US...

The simplest way to get your donations to us is a bank transfer, please contact the office for our bank details. We also accept cheques and cash, don't forget to update your offline donations on your 'giving page'.

6) AFTER YOUR EVENT HAS FINISHED...
